Sweet Treats: A Step-By-Step Hair Recipe

"Kiss-Me Valentine" Chignon...



1. After applying your favorite styling product (my favorite is the Grooming Crème from Bumble & bumble), part your hair on the desired side. Blow-dry using a boar bristle round brush to help smooth out the frizz.
2. Using a hot tool, take a one-and-a-half inch section and curl hair from the middle to the ends. The larger the barrel size of the curling iron the looser the curl. Try using 1" to 1.5" sized barrel.
3. For added volume, back-comb if desired. Now, beginning from the opposite side of the part, twist hair starting from your ear in an upward motion, pinning along the nape of the head until you reach the other ear.
4. Gently shape the remaining curls. Pin in desired location.
5. Tame any fly-aways with a light hairspray.
6. Add a little flair if desired, to make this look your own. Perhaps some candy hearts or petite roses... the possibilities are endless with this classic up-do!

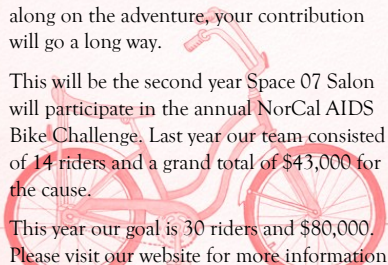
This year our goal is 30 riders and \$80,000. Please visit our website for more information
